Worth watching, by George

FANS of former Hobart singer-songwriter Anita George have a final chance to hear her fusion of acoustic folk-pop next week before she heads overseas to Canada and South America.

Since moving to Melbourne in 2003, George has emerged as "one to watch" on the Australian music scene, captivating audiences around the country with her rich voice and poetic lyrics.

George, who was a grand finalist in the 2005 Australian Busking Championships, has released two CDs so far — *Shooting for the Moon*, which was released in July last year, and *The River*, which came out in October.

Anita George and cellist Daniel McCracken Hewson play on the Apron Stage at the Taste of Tasmania from 11.30am-2pm on January 3, and then at the Re-

public Bar in North Hobart from 8.30 that night, supported by Melbourne artist Simon Phillips.

George and McCracken Hewson also play at Irish Murphy's at Salamanca Place from 10pm on January 4, and at Launceston's Royal Oak Hotel from 8pm on January 6, again supported by Simon Phillips.
